The film production company Zazarfilm was founded in 2007 by a director/producer Zaza Rusadze in Tbilisi, Georgia. Zazarfilm aims to develop, produce and co-produce author driven documentary and feature films.

In 2009 the company has completed its first production, a short film by Zaza Rusadze FOLDS AND CRACKS. The film received Discovery Award at 19th Festival of East European Cinema in Cottbus, Germany.

In 2013 Zazarfilm's first feature length production, the directorial debut by Zaza Rusadze A FOLD IN MY BLANKET, world-premiered at 63rd Berlin International Film Festival as opening film of the Panorama. A FOLD IN MY BLANKET received the Award for Best Feature Film at 17th Queer Lisboa International Film Festival and was subsequently released on DVD in Germany.

In 2013 European Film Promotion EFP has selected Zaza Rusadze and his company, as an emerging producer from across Europe, to participate in the networking platform PRODUCERS ON THE MOVE at the 66th Cannes International Film Festival.

In 2015 Zazarfilm's latest production, a feature length documentary by Salome Machaidze, Tamuna Karumidze and David Meskhi WHEN THE EARTH SEEMS TO BE LIGHT received the IDFA 2015 Award for Best First Appearance at International Documentary Film Festival in Amsterdam.

Zazarfilm currently develops its next international documentary and feature film projects.



BIOGRAPHY DIRECTOR / PRODUCER - ZAZA RUSADZE

Zaza Rusadze was born in Tbilisi, Georgia in 1977. Rusadze worked for the Georgian State TV for several years. In 1996 he was accepted at the film school HFF "Konrad Wolf" in Potsdam in directing class and moved to Germany.

During his study Zaza has worked as News Cutter for German TV Channels and as a translator for the Film Festivals in Berlin, Leipzig and Cottbus. In 2003 Zaza Rusadze received his degree in directing. Zaza worked as assistant director on film sets of Ineke Smits, Dito Tsintsadze, Otar Ioseliani, Julia Lokttev, Thierry and Téona Grenade, Martin Koolhoven.

In 2007 Rusadze founded the Film Production and Distribution Company Zazarfilm in Tbilisi and splits his time between Europe and Georgia since. From 2015 Zaza works in the Selection Committee of the International Leipzig Festival for Documentary and Animated Film.

Dmitrij's monotonous days drag on, between working in the courthouse and his solitary rock-climbing excursions. In his endeavors to escape the stifling conformity of a provincial town, Dmitrij gradually begins to integrate his newly met friend Andrej in his fantasy world. Then Andrej vanishes... Back in reality: Dmitrij learns that Andrej has been accused of murder. Dmitrij offers to testify, to cover for his friend and to convince the court that at the time of the murder he and Andrej were on a rock-climbing trip. Dmitrij's evidence obviously stems from his daydream. The testimony is met with disbelief at the court hearing. Andrej is ultimately convicted, and, although all would seem lost, Dmitrij begins to nurture a spiritual rebellion within his soul.

A young rock climber envisions the beautiful mountain landscape with dried lake as a non-accessible place of his desire. The place, which he takes to be real, only exists in his dreams as a conceptual idea. One day he wakes up in the reality of ongoing war, which he sees as flood of images on TV screen: tanks rolling, soldiers shooting and old ancient forests burning... Longing to escape the war and discover the illusionary place of his fantasy, he creates an imaginary friend to follow him throughout his dreamy journey.

Together with his made-up friend he starts ascending high rocks and mountains, so he could stand above the clouds and escape the war images in beauty of nature. Soon he finds himself alone in sad revelation. Apparently the woods in his illusionary escape world have caught the fire and not only the forests in TV images.
